

Minutes of the Directors of Loghill Village Parks and Recreation District

Date: April 4, 2026.

Meeting called to order at 4:33 PM.

Agenda Item 1: Approval of the minutes of last meeting.

Motioned and approved.

Agenda Item 2: Treasurer's report.

Bill Hall presented the Treasurer's report and it is posted on the website. Motioned and approved.

Agenda Item 3: Possible projects for 2026.

The Board is still discussing a possible new trail which would drop below the escarpment, either routed as a loop or continuing on to the valley floor (at CR 24).

The proposed trail would transect one parcel of private property. Bill Hall contacted that property's owner and the owner's response to providing an easement was positive.

Dave Underwood asked a local wildlife specialist with Colorado Parks and Wildlife about the possible effects and prescribed mitigations raised by the proposed trail. Underwood was told a seasonal closure in winter would be advisable to allow wildlife - especially elk - an undisturbed refuge during their most

vulnerable season. It was also advised that signage on the trail should warn hikers of possible mountain lion encounters.

There are a few projects that may require attention in the coming year. The Board would like to find one company that can address them all. Among them:

- Bench repair or replacement, depending on need
- Steps installed on the short, loose-gravel slope which drops from the mail kiosk parking lot to the Escarpment Trail.
- Re-staining the pavilion shelter and picnic tables

Rich Niemeier and Cyndi Nelson will both contact companies they know that may wish to take on the work.
